HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE EUROPEAN CHAPTER MINUTES (Oct. '89)

- o Financial support needs to be encouraged (over 200 members do not contribute)
- o Reinstated professed tertiaries will be given a counsellor for twelve months to assist them.
- o New ways are being explored to help visiting/travelling tertiaries link up with "locals".
- o The upper age limit for admission to the Order has been removed.
- o Chapter has been asked to provide or suggest ways and means by which tertiaries may be more effectual in their professed lifestyle, especially with regard to the environment.

- o The official publication, The Chronicle, is now being printed by the Poor Clare sisters at Freeland

- o Deputy Minister Elisabeth Stirling was a member of the Evangelism Steering Group, looking at the Decade of Evangelism; The First Order is planning a conference in June 1990 for the same emphasis. The entire Third Order was urged to support this Decade of Evangelism (declared by the Lambeth Conference and to start in 1990).
