**FROM SOUTH AFRICA CHAPTER** (Held in Durban, Oct. '89)

- o Br. Geoffrey noted new legislation which prohibits First Order holding admin. post in Third Order. Reported that a new Minister would have to be elected for the African Province. The next meeting of the APTOC is scheduled for 30 Sept.- 7 Oct, 1990, at which time discussion of the new Minister and the structure of the Province will take place.
- o Natal - Murder and threats of murder seem to be the order of the day. One Tertiary, her cousin (a priest) and his family killed, has had to abandon her home in fear of her life, her family now is scattered looking for a safe haven.
- o Cape Town - Anglican Tertiaries were invited to join with R.C.s in their observance of the Transitus at Schoenstatt Convent, Constantia. Four Anglicans attended.
- o Johannesburg - The group has a focus on the dramatic arts ("Heaven alone knows why!" they report). The last sketch they wrote was based on the incident with the Crucifix at San Damiano, and was used at St. Aidan's, Yeoville "with much laughter"!
- o Lesotho - It seems that the diocese received R8436-55 in Franciscan aid last year. This money was used to cover fees of 30 students from poor families and for feeding 20 destitute people. This is an area sorely hit by high unemployment, inflation and taxes.
