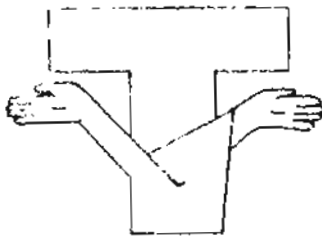

## GLEANINGS

From "News of the American Province,  
Society of St. Francis", December 1980:

- Peter Nelson to become a novice January 6, 1981. Postulants Lee Brunner and Dusty Atwood going to Bishop's Ranch in January. Douglas Hughes to Little Portion in January. John Rohim at Little Portion for January and then to go to the west coast. Robert Bryant withdrew from the community.

The Little Portion Brothers are experimenting using the Antiphons from the new Prayer Book Office. (These are in addition to those in the Prayer Book, including antiphons for all the canticles as well as for all the psalms.)

..A pamphlet came from SSF, Plaistow, London, about the Conference of SSF 1981, "The Gospel Now". The Committee is encouraged by the comments being received, and they are centered around: (1) vocation and mission of the Church, (2) personal holiness and lifestyle, (3) signs of the times and the Christian hope. The Committee stresses the importance of hearing about our beliefs and concerns, rather than for us to feel bound to discuss the material sent to us. (Our Third Order representatives are Dee Dobson and Kale King.)

The Conference on the Religious Life in the Americas circulated a Statement, concluding with - "we, religious of both the Anglican and Roman Catholic communions, urge all religious of both communions to give priority to the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, January 18-25, 1981, as an expression of the essence of our vocation".
