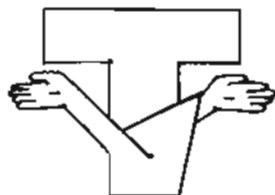

ST FRANCIS, THE THIRD ORDER AND PEACE

St Francis preached peace with all, we have the opportunity to participate in INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PEACE. Tuesday, September, 18, 1984. 12 noon - a minute of silence, 12:01 - moment of sound. This has been proclaimed in a unanimous resolution by all member nations of the United Nations. The United Nations General Assembly will be convening in New York City and, at that very moment, will be observing their traditional moment of silence with which they begin their year's work. Where ever we are, at 12 noon on September 18, shall we observe this small time for peace?
