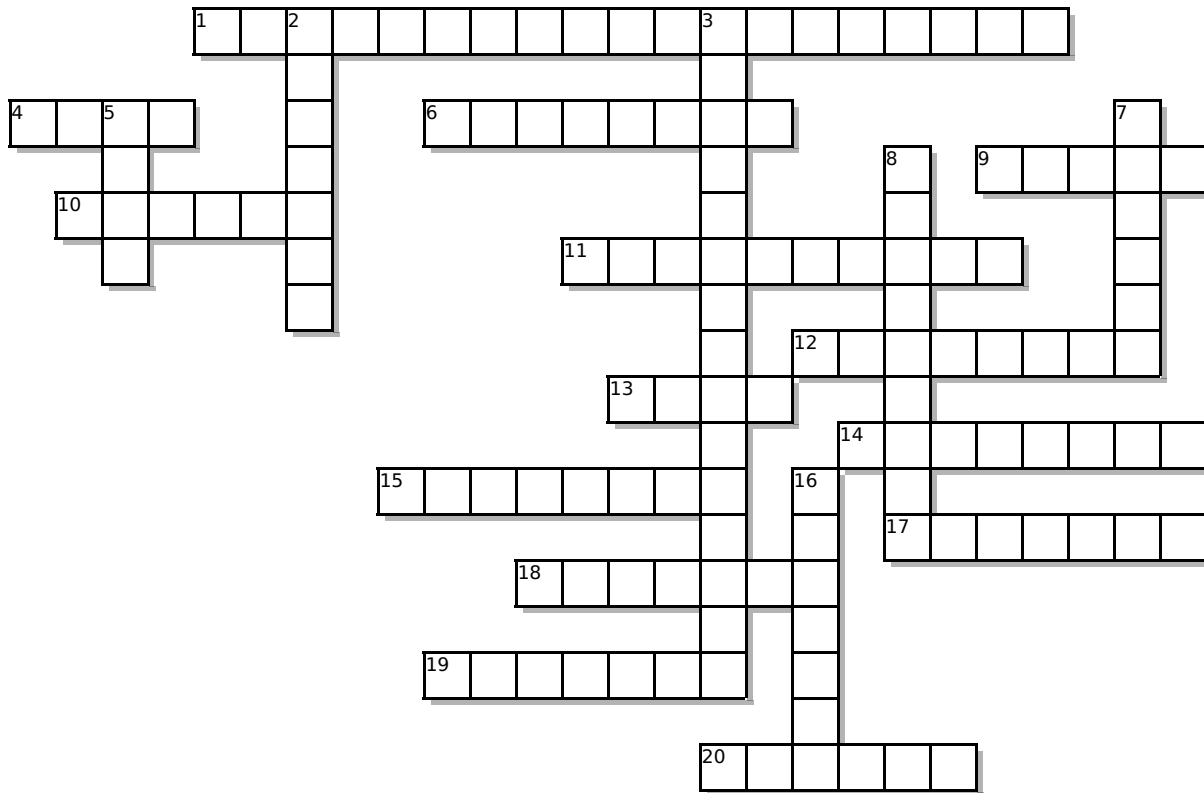


# Third Order Day 1 Puzzle

### ACROSS

- 1 The Community of the Transfiguration arose out of St. Luke's Church, Cincinnati in 1898, and another Order tried to arise from the same church in 1917. Their founding houses were two blocks apart on Freeman Avenue, Cincinnati. The name of this 1917 Order was \_\_\_\_\_ (no spaces between words).

- 15 The eight Anglo-Catholic beliefs of the \_\_\_\_\_ (1921) marked the Order of St. Francis as "a maximum expression of Catholic belief against the narrowness of outlook and the littleness of prejudice which are common

afflictions of fallen man."

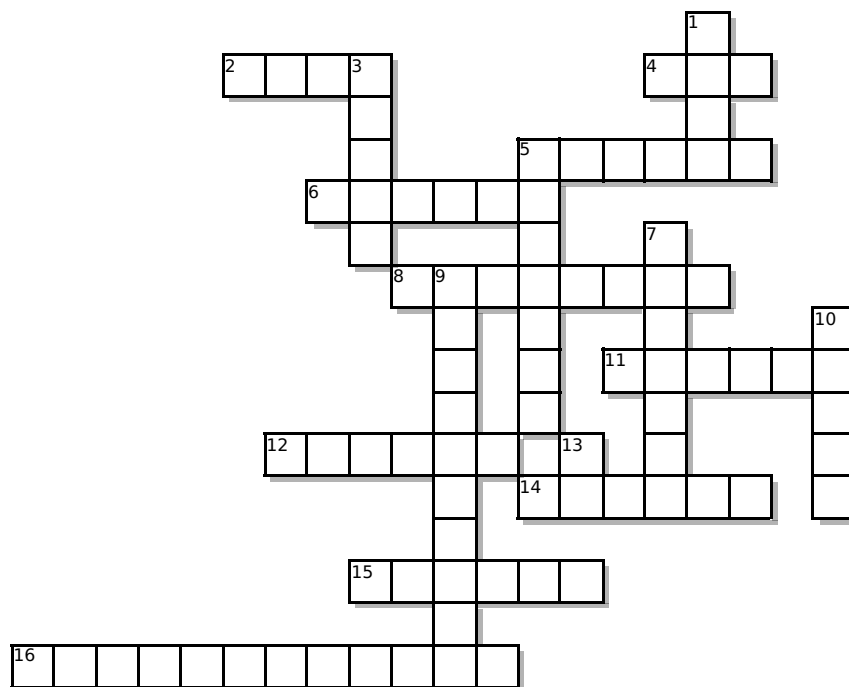
- 17 Before the Third Order became self-governing in 1973, Alvah \_\_\_\_\_ became President of the Third Order Cooperation, and his wife became Secretary General.
- 18 The 1st and 2nd Orders were successfully founded here in Wisconsin. The name of the city in Wisconsin was \_\_\_\_\_.
- 19 In 1928, Father Joseph moved the Order of St. Francis from Merrill, Wisconsin to Little \_\_\_\_\_ in Mount Sinai, New York on the north shore of Long Island.

- 2 The Rev. \_\_\_\_\_ Morse-Boycott led our London Custodia (a.k.a. Fellowship) from 1931-1950.
- 3 The Community of the \_\_\_\_\_ is only one of the two Orders still based in Cincinnati.
- 5 Emily Gardiner \_\_\_\_\_, the Third Order famous healer, was given shelter at the end of her life by this Cincinnati Community, the Community of the Transfiguration.
- 7 John \_\_\_\_\_ crossed waterfalls, blistering savannahs, and negotiated obstacle-strewn and virtually impassable mountain paths in order to serve the Amerindian peoples in Guyana of the Upper Mazaruni and Upper Cuyuni Region. ### ACROSS

- 2 The most spectacular moment in the 2002 Provincial Convocation in Santa Barbara came when there was a laying on of hands on all individuals present by three clergy members: our own Father Masud, Rabbi Carlos Huerta, and \_\_\_\_\_ Mohammad Bashar Arafat.
- 4 The second largest exodus in the history of the province occurred in 1992-3 in response to Alden's election as Minister Provincial. He was an openly \_\_\_\_\_ man.
- 5 To put more emphasis on Fellowships, Dee (see Q 16) worked with Marie \_\_\_\_\_. Marie was the "Fellowship Contact Person" with John Scott for three years and then was re-appointed as Fellowship Coordinator in 1982 and remained as Coordinator for the next nine years until she was elected as Provincial Chaplain. In 1983 there were 25 Fellowships in the Province, and four regional convocations each year. When Marie stepped down in 1992, there were 38 Fellowships and eight regional convocations.
- 6 \_\_\_\_\_ Robinson was unanimously elected 'Directress-In-Waiting' since, according to The Manual, she could not yet be the Director. This preceded her profession by about one month. She worked with the Diggers in Haight-Asbury during the Summer of Love to counsel "our draft-troubled youth, of whom we have many here in San Francisco." She and MaryAnn Jackman (who drew the Dancing Francis logo) basically started TSSF in California—the 1st Order Brothers and Sisters arrived later. She left the Order in the 1980s, but not Franciscan spirituality which today she endeavors to live out as a 6th-degree black belt Aikido sensei in Tucson.
- 8 The Rev. Robert Hugh was first a \_\_\_\_\_ before becoming Br. Robert Hugh.
- 11 Minister Provincial Anita Catron (Miner) described her preaching and teaching mission with Brs. Clark and Carey to the Diocese of \_\_\_\_\_ as one of the most rewarding experiences of her two terms as MP.
- 12 Hugo \_\_\_\_\_ served in far north Quebec among the Inland Cree Indians.
- 14 Dee \_\_\_\_\_ had three terms in office as Provincial Guardian and first Minister Provincial (1981-90), and the cumulative effect of her work and the Chapter's decisions was to decentralize the focus of the Province and put more emphasis on Fellowships and Area Convocations.
- 15 \_\_\_\_\_ Richards was a nurse on the teaching staff of

the Port of Spain General Hospital and was one of the leaders of the charismatic movement in the Anglican Church in Trinidad and Tobago. \_\_\_\_\_ Richards was the first person professed in Trinidad (1980) and she became Area Chaplain, Fellowship Convener, and a member of Chapter for many years beginning in 1982.

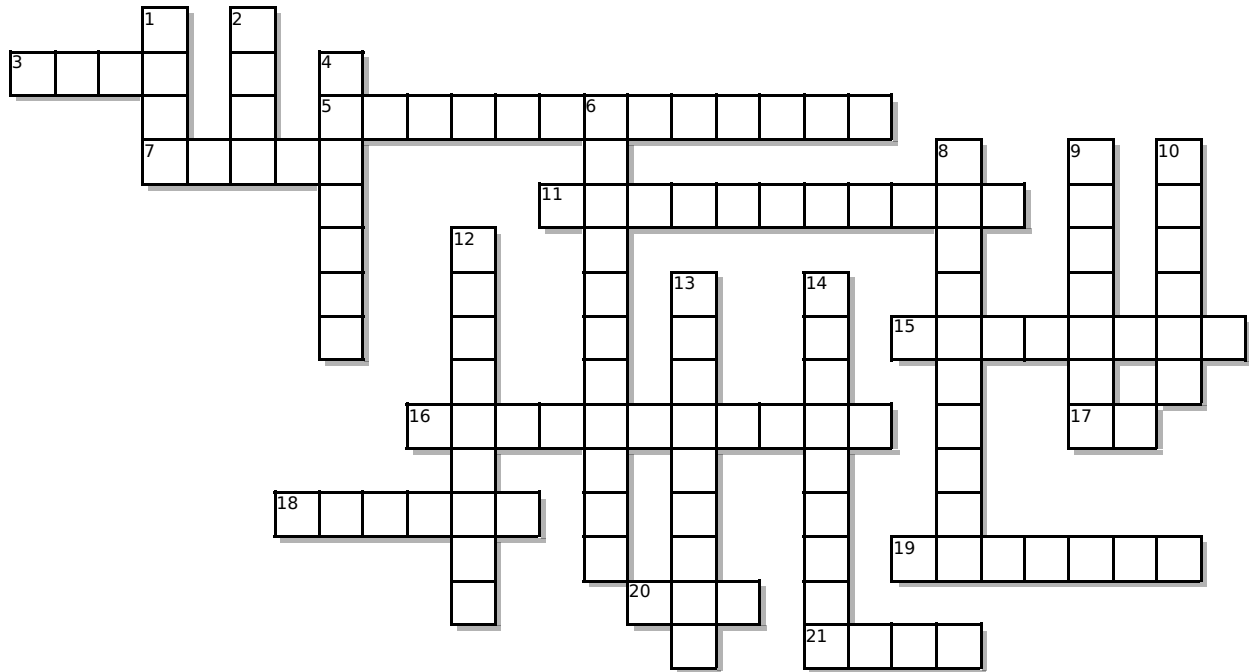
- 10 During the John Scott era, the annual meetings of Provincial Chapter and the Standing Committee were accompanied by a General Chapter to which all were invited. (Exactly the arrangement of this Provincial Convocation and Chapter). The first was held at Little Portion in New York; the second in Redwood City in California; the third in Racine Wisconsin; and the fourth at the surprising location of \_\_\_\_\_ Arkansas.

### DOWN

- 1 \_\_\_\_\_ King was Provincial Guardian for only one year (1980-1). \_\_\_\_\_ continued, however, to provide leadership in TSSF as seen by his elections to Chapter and by taking on the emergency role of Interim Provincial Chaplain in 1994-5. He explained his inability to continue as Provincial Guardian was because he was an isolated tertiary in Idaho with no Fellowship to surround him and support him.
- 3 After only two years of profession, \_\_\_\_\_ S. became the second Provincial Chaplain. (Hint, he is presenting a panel at this convocation.)
- 5 Alden \_\_\_\_\_ became the first member of our province to be elected as Minister General of all of TSSF.
- 7 The Provincial Convocation of 1997 in New \_\_\_\_\_ was the biggest undertaking of the American Province in over a decade...and probably the biggest undertaking ever.
- 9 In 1980, Dale Trana petitioned the Third Order to accept her as a postulant, so that she could learn the spiritual disciplines with guidance. Even though she was a United Church of Christ pastor, she was accepted into the formation program. Dale went on with others to take her Third Order formation experience to help found the Order of \_\_\_\_\_ Franciscans.
- 10 Provincial Guardian John Scott had a former 1st Order brother, The Rev. Robert Goode, as his Provincial Chaplain. Goode balanced John's liberal activism with a bit of conservatism. Goode also had a funny nickname. What was it \_\_\_\_\_?

- 10 Clue 7. We are members of the Franciscan \_\_\_\_\_ Network, a Washington, DC lobbying group acting as a Franciscan ethical/moral presence in domestic US politics.
- 12 Clue 9. Bishop Mark \_\_\_\_\_, one of our six TSSF professed bishops, who is part of the Ojibway people, was recruited by the Canadian Anglican Church to be the National Indigenous People's Bishop.
- 13 Clue 19. Tom Johnson both as bursar and as Minister Provincial has been a supporter of Kathryn \_\_\_\_\_'s medical missions to Liberia.
- 14 Clue 3. In 2004, Minister Provincial Masud Ibn Syedullah, and a number of other key leaders journeyed to Brazil with a \_\_\_\_\_ to meet with the Primate of Brazil, Dom Orlando Santos de Oliveira. Dom Orlando signed the \_\_\_\_\_ and offered ongoing support. He also noted that the TSSF's presence was not a U.S. idea, but a response to Brazil's invitation.
