

ZIMBABWE

Their Third Order Chapter met November 13, 1982 with twelve present, under the chairmanship of Brother Geoffrey, SSF. The Chapel of S. Francis, donated to Seke, was being used for daily Eucharist, instructions for Baptism and Confirmation, meetings for the Ministers' Fraternal, interdenominational Mothers' Union, and clubs. Financial aid is needed. It was recommended that novices and counselors should remind each other about reporting. A minimum subscription of \$5 from each tertiary was requested, to take care of manuals, crosses, correspondence, etc. Bishop Elijah Masuko said he was very grateful for money from the Franciscan Aid fund, used in stewardship and other projects. Salathiel Madziyire penned a note at the bottom of the Minutes: "We send you our Franciscan love - and good wishes from T/O. Zimbabwe."
