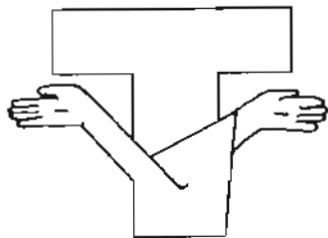

On April 29, 1984 in San Francisco there was held a Ministers' Meeting of the First Order of the Society of St Francis and a First Order Brothers Conference.

some Quotes:

The Rt. Rev. Paul Moore, Junior, Bishop of New York and Protector General of the Society of St Francis:

"...the struggle for the kingdom is taking place on many levels: the survival of the earth itself; the survival of the church of the body of Christ; the ongoing care of his children by the Lord Jesus until he comes... The greatest threat to creation today is nuclear and chemical warfare and technological pollution...Waging peace is a spiritual matter. We, as Franciscans, are to be instruments of peace, both as individuals and as a community...the church has to become impregnated with the spirit of Francis, which was so like our Lord's..."

Br. Geoffrey, SSF Minister General:

"...There has been a fresh outreach to the poor and deprived in our Provinces, and a greater concern, especially in the Third Order, for the Third World expressed in the development of the Franciscan Aid Fund which has been undertaken by the Third Order...There are varying degrees of commitment and ways of expression of this commitment, but I rejoice in this overall passionate desire for peace and righteousness in our world, and for the proclamation of the Kingdom of God..."

Br Robert Hugh, SSF, Minister Provincial of the American Province:

"This year on September 14th the American Province becomes a Senior Citizen - 65 years since the founding of OSF by Father Joseph. As we look at our life I believe we do see a wealth of experience, some joyous some painful, and an ongoing process of growth into maturity...At this time there are 31 brothers in this Province: 20 life Professed, 4 in first Profession, 5 novices, and 2 postulants...Br Stephen, 50 years in Life Profession, Br Leo 50 years in profession...both are presently doing well and give so much to our life."
