

- Opening Centering Prayer (20 mins)
- · Lament (1 hour)
 - Participants will visit a local site representing ecological harm or degradation. Practices may include walking meditation, journaling, prayer, or photo journaling.
 - Optional: Submit photos to be shared in a group slideshow.
- · Action & Contemplation (1 hour)
 - Participants will move to a site that symbolizes ecological hope or action. A guide of practical suggestions will support reflection and engagement.
 - Optional: Submit photos from this segment for community reflection.
- Reconciliation & Sharing (1 hour)
 - Return to Zoom for sacred storytelling. Each participant will be invited to briefly share their experience (approx. 3 minutes depending on registration size). Curators will share submitted photos as a visual prayer of collective witness.
- Closing Prayer (10 mins)
